Wounded Warrior Call Center open for business: Ceremony to be held Friday

MCB QUANTICO, Va. – The Wounded Warrior Regiment and Serco Inc. will host a dedication and ribbon cutting for the Wounded Warrior Call Center Friday at 12 p.m. at the Wounded Warrior Call Center.

The Wounded Warrior Call Center began its 24-hour, seven-days-a-week operations Nov. 19 and is designed to provide information, resources and advocacy for our wounded, ill and injured Marines and sailors and their family members.

The Wounded Warrior Regiment, commanded by Col. Gregory Boyle, is headquartered in Quantico, Va. The regiment was established in April 2007 and provides assistance to wounded, ill and injured Marines and sailors during their recovery. The WWR is supported by two battalions: Wounded Warrior Battalion East, located in Camp Lejeune, N.C., and Wounded Warrior Battalion West, located in Camp Pendleton, Calif.

The Wounded Warrior Call Center is fully operated by an experienced staff of Serco employees, retired Marines, former Marines and family members of Marines. It is located in Dumfries, Va.

The ceremony will be held at Serco Inc., 2525 Pointe Center Court Ste. 150, Dumfries, VA 22026.
